

# Submission Guidelines

Zócalo is a new small press launching in spring 2009 with four series: *Demons*, *The Road*, *Letters* and *Water*.

We are currently accepting work for the next two series:

## **Age**

This series title is open to interpretation and need not feature anywhere in your work. There are no restrictions on the kind of writing you may submit. Fiction or non-fiction prose, poetry, as well as work which may not be readily classified as such, are all welcome.

## **Travel Writing**

This series is dedicated to prose writing concerned with travel. Beyond this there are no restrictions on the subject matter. While "travel writing" is a recognised genre, we are open to work which may seem to stretch its boundaries.

## **THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES APPLY TO BOTH NEW SERIES:**

### **Length**

Work should be between 1,000 and 1,800 words, or no longer than 180 lines for poetry (whether one or several poems).

### **Closing date for submissions**

All submissions must be with us by **Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2009**. You may submit as many pieces of work as you wish.

### **Information we need from you**

Please supply your contact details and indicate for each piece of work the series in which you would expect it to be included. If you feel that writing under a pseudonym would give you greater freedom or benefit your work in any way, we would encourage this.

### **Payment**

Unfortunately, we are not currently in a position to pay anyone for their work.
